1. **ASN Science Policy Fellowship**

- a. Applications open in **October** and close in **December**. Applicant must be a member of the American Society for Nutrition.
- b. Length: 1-year.
- c. Location: Science Policy Fellows are based at their home institution.

5. **Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Health Policy Fellowship:**
 - a. Applications open in **August** and close in **November** for a fellowship position to start the following year.
 - b. Length: The fellowship begins in September with a 3.5-month orientation, and fellowship placements generally begin no later than January 31st. The fellowship is a full-time 12-month residency from September – August, with option to request approval to extend through the legislative session until December 31st.
 - c. Location: The fellow will be required to be in person in Washington, DC.
