



Encore Abstract Presentations

Submission Deadline: May 11, 2026

Beginning on April 6, the American Society for Nutrition (ASN) welcomes abstract submissions of research recently presented at other scientific conferences.

What is an Encore Abstract?

Scientific research recently presented at a scientific conference as an abstract in the form of a poster or oral presentation between June 1, 2025 and July 24, 2026 – excluding NUTRITION 2025. Abstracts previously presented at ASN’s NUTRITION meetings are not eligible for submission.

Accepted Encore Abstracts will be presented in poster sessions at NUTRITION 2026. All presentations will be given in-person only.

A limited number of Encore Abstracts will be accepted.

Why Submit an Encore Abstract?

- **Maximize Your Exposure:** Presenting at NUTRITION 2026 allows your findings to be seen by a different, highly engaged audience, expanding visibility beyond their original debut.

Eligibility and Details

Eligibility Criteria:

Scientific research recently presented as an abstract presentation (e.g., as a poster or oral presentation) at a scientific conference **between June 1, 2025 and July 24, 2026, excluding NUTRITION 2025**.

Abstracts previously presented at ASN's NUTRITION meeting are not eligible to be submitted.

Accepted Encore Abstracts will be presented in poster sessions at NUTRITION 2026. All presentations will be given in-person only.

A limited number of Encore Abstracts will be accepted.

All submissions will be reviewed for quality assurance. Reviewers will consider the following when evaluating abstract submissions: submission components (e.g. objective, methods, results and conclusions), significance, and writing quality.

NUTRITION 2026 Encore Abstract submissions are not eligible for inclusion in ASN's award competitions and will not be published in *Current Developments in Nutrition*.

Meeting Participation:

Submission of an Encore Abstract constitutes a commitment by the presenting author to present at NUTRITION 2026 if the submission is accepted. All presentations will be given in-person only at NUTRITION 2026. Failure to present, if not justified, will jeopardize future acceptance of submissions for ASN conferences. Presenting authors associated with an Encore Abstract must register as a full-conference attendee or for a one-day pass for the meeting. The registration fee and travel costs are separate from the abstract submission fee. Authors are responsible for all travel expenses (airfare, food, hotel, etc.) associated with presenting at the meeting. [Click here](#) to visit the NUTRITION 2026 Registration and Housing website.

Notifications: Notifications will be sent by email regarding if the Encore Abstract has been accepted for presentation by May 25, 2026.

Withdrawal: To withdraw an Encore Abstract, written notification must be sent to education@nutrition.org.

Submission Instructions

The information listed below must be included in each Encore Abstract submission. Encore Abstracts must be submitted through the [NUTRITION 2026 Abstract Submission website](#).

1. **Title:** The submission title should be entered in Title Case and be short and specific. The submission title has a character limit of 150 characters not including spaces.
2. **Presenting Author Academic Level:** The academic level of the presenting author must be indicated.
3. **Author Information:** A presenting author must be added to a submission. Co-authors can also be added. Contact information (organization, email address, country) and credentials (degree) must be provided. Please follow the directions listed to confirm and complete

presenting author and co-author profiles. All co-authors listed for the previous scientific conference abstract presentation must be disclosed.

4. **Encore Abstract Information:**

- a. **Submission Text:** Submissions must include Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusions, and Funding Sources. The submission body has a character limit of 2000 characters not including spaces. When entering the submission body, please proof the information carefully to confirm that any special characters (such as α , β , etc.) are displaying properly.
- b. **Prior Abstract Presentation Details:** The name of the scientific conference and date the work was previously presented must be provided. If the Encore Abstract submission is accepted, this information will be included on the NUTRITION 2026 online schedule planner and mobile app with the submission text.

5. **Encore Abstract Authors' Statement and Agreement:** The presenting author must confirm that (1) all authors are authorized to submit the Encore Abstract submission on behalf of the presenting author and co-authors, (2) the presenting author has received permission from their collaborators to present the submission at NUTRITION 2026 if it is accepted, and (3) the Encore Abstract submission does not violate the copyright of any other individual, organization, or publication.

6. **Submission Fee:** Presenting authors are required to pay a non-refundable fee for each Encore Abstract submission. ASN members receive exclusive discounts on Encore Abstract submission, NUTRITION 2026 registration, plus other member benefits! If you are unsure about your ASN member status, please email mem@nutrition.org.

a. **ASN Member Fee: \$145**

- i. To qualify for discounted member submission fees, submitters must be active members of ASN at the time of submission.

b. **Non-member Fee: \$170**

- i. If you are not an active ASN member and are interested in member-only pricing for abstract submission, [click here](#). Joining ASN today will also unlock many other exclusive benefits, such as discounted NUTRITION 2026 registration and more! Once your membership application has been submitted, please allow 1-2 business days for approval. After your ASN membership has been activated, return to the [NUTRITION 2026 Abstract Submission website](#) to complete your submission. ASN will not reimburse the difference between the member and non-member submission fees to any individual who submits an Encore Abstract prior to becoming a member.
- c. A credit card (American Express, Discover, MasterCard or Visa) will be required for payment. No refunds will be provided if the submission is withdrawn or not accepted. The submission fee is separate from the meeting registration fee.

7. **Submission Completion:** Once all tasks for the submission are complete, on the submission's task list page submitters should click the 'Next' and 'Submit' to officially complete the submission. A confirmation email will be sent to the submitter. Submissions can be revised until the May 11, 2026, 11:59 PM ET deadline.
