NUTRITION 2026 REGISTRATION POLICIES

MEMBERSHIP

- To qualify for the discounted member registration rates, NUTRITION 2026 registrants must be active members of ASN at the time of registration, or they must purchase the *Join Now* option.
- ASN will not reimburse the difference between the member and nonmember registration rates to any attendee who registers prior to becoming a member.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Americans with Disabilities Act:** If you require an accommodation to participate fully in either experience option while attending NUTRITION 2026, please email meetings@nutrition.org.
- For security reasons, all participants in Nutrition 2026 must be officially registered.
- All badge printing is done onsite. i. Badges must be worn and visible at all times. If you misplace your badge onsite, a new badge must be purchased at the replacement cost \$50.00. A photo ID will be required at the time of replacement.
- Photo identification is required when picking up registration materials on site. Registrants may only pick up their own credentials.

- NUTRITION 2026 educational programming is available on a first-come, first-served basis, including paid conference sessions. ASN recommends arriving early to all scheduled conference activities to guarantee entrance into the room(s).

REGISTRATION CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Partial Refunds:

- Cancellation requests received by **11:59 PM CT on May 1, 2026**, will receive a 75% refund.
- Cancellation requests received between **May 2 and 11:59 PM CT on June 12, 2026**, will receive a 50% refund.
- After 11:59 PM CT on June 12, 2026**, registration fees are non-refundable.
- No refunds will be given for no shows.

How to Request a Partial Refund:

- Refund requests must be received in writing by **11:59 PM CT on June 12, 2026**.
- All cancellation and refund requests must be submitted in writing via email to asn@nutrition.org.
- All attempts will be made to process refunds within 30 days of cancellation. All refunds will be issued back to the original payment type. Cash and money order payments will be refunded by check.

Non-Refundable:

After **11:59 PM CT on June 12, 2026**, registration fees are non-refundable.

- No-shows (registrants who do not attend) will not receive refunds.
- Donations to ASN are non-refundable.
- ASN One-year Join Now Membership fees are non-refundable.
- Tickets to the ASN Class of 2023 Fellows, 50-Year Members and Past Presidents Luncheon are non-refundable after **11:59 PM CT on June 12, 2026**.

SUBSTITUTIONS

- Name changes, substitutions and badge-sharing are **not** allowed.

GUEST POLICY

- A guest is defined as a spouse, significant other, friend or an adult child (18 years old or older) who is not in a nutrition science or practice related field. A colleague, associate, spouse, or significant other who works or studies within the nutrition science or practice field must register as a professional attendee.
- Each registered attendee can add one (1) guest 18-year-old or older
- Guests must be registered to attend NUTRITION 2026. The guest registration fee includes 3 days of access to The Hub and Welcome Reception held on Saturday evening. Guests do not have access to sessions and cannot claim continuing education credits.
- All guests must present a valid government issued photo ID and be accompanied by the conference registrant before receiving a badge onsite.
- An additional charge is required to attend the ASN Distinguished Fellows, 50-Year Members, and Past Presidents Luncheon.

CHILD POLICY

- Everyone who attends NUTRITION 2026 must be registered and have a badge. Badges for children are free and available onsite at the registration desk.
- All children under the age of 18 will register onsite to receive access to the meeting. Children must be present at the time of registration to receive their badge. Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Guardians are asked to help maintain a professional, disturbance-free exhibition environment.

- Photographing slides of oral presentations and posters without the express permission of the presenter/author
- Recording of scientific and other sessions without the express permission of the participants
- Sustained disruption of scientific sessions or other events
- Unwelcome and uninvited attention or contact
- Physical assault (including unwelcome touch or groping)
- Real or implied threat of physical harm
