#### A collaborative national infrastructure

The Hub connects, organizes, and elevates existing nutrition education efforts. Its purpose is to help medical schools and partners identify trusted resources, learn from successful models, and support practical implementation.



**Core message:** ASN is not creating a new curriculum or duplicating existing programs. The goal is to help the field succeed together by convening partners, aligning efforts, and supporting implementation.

Nutrition is fully integrated into medical education and applied in clinical practice.



#### Mission

Advance, strengthen, and sustain nutrition education through alignment of curricula, faculty development, partnerships, and evaluation.

#### Competency Alignment

Align nutrition competencies, frameworks, and educational objectives.
