1. Pre-eminent and recognized leader in the nutrition community.
2. Visionary and strategic thinker. Demonstrated ability creating new and innovative programs within their sphere of influence.
3. Successful leadership and service on ASN Groups Engaging Members (GEMS)- Committees, Research Interest Sections, Councils and Task Forces.
4. Commitment to participate in up to three in-person board meetings a year. ASN Board members are asked to help secure external funding and to provide financial support to ASN's Annual Giving, Special Events and/or other campaigns that benefit ASN's current and future membership.
5. Positive leadership attributes; emotional intelligence; ability to work collaboratively and engage in appropriate debate and discussion when needed.

Open Positions

Vice President-Elect ***Vice President Elect:*** The Vice President Elect shall serve a term of one year. This person shall serve as a member of the ASN Board of Directors for a total of four years, holding each of the following offices for consecutive one-year terms: Vice President Elect; Vice President; President; and Past President. As President, this member shall serve as the Society's chief elected officer and shall work closely with the Board of Directors, Committees, RIS and GEMS, Chief Executive Officer and staff in formulating and advancing ASN programs for the benefit of our members and global stakeholders. *This officer serves a four-year term.*

Treasurer-Elect ***Treasurer Elect:*** The Treasurer shall serve as Chair of the Finance Committee and, whether performed personally or through the Chief Executive Officer, shall be responsible for safeguarding the Society's funds, for disbursing same in accordance with the approved budget, for maintaining proper records and accounts, and for preparing and submitting an annual report to the membership detailing the financial status of the Society. *The Treasurer shall serve in the position of Treasurer-Elect for one year and then serve a three-year term as Treasurer.*

Secretary ***Secretary:*** As Secretary, this member shall serve as the Chair of the Membership Committee, be responsible for verifying that the office of the Chief Executive Officer maintains a roster of the members, keeps minutes of the meetings of the Society and of the Board of Directors, and shall handle official correspondence of the Society. *The elected candidate serves a three-year term.*

Director-At-Large ***Global Nutrition:*** Global Nutrition members conduct nutrition research of relevance to other (often less-developed) countries. Their research includes undernutrition, deficiency diseases, obesity, diet-related chronic disease; relationships between infection and nutrition; nutrition interventions and their evaluation; and economic development policy and nutrition. This knowledge is translated into training, policies and programs. *The elected candidate serves a two-year term.*

Director-At-Large ***Nutrition Population Science:*** Nutrition Population Science members are involved in nutritional epidemiology and public health nutrition research. The members review how diet influences population health; the development and evaluation of nutritional strategies; and programs to improve public health. Their research covers nutrition-related factors that impact health, including individual behavior, environmental, social, and economic factors. *The elected candidate serves a two-year term.*

Director-At-Large ***Medical Clinical Nutrition:*** Members of the Medical/Clinical Nutrition cover clinical, research, educational, and/or training aspects of nutrition and metabolism as related to prevention and treatment of disease and optimal health, including complementary and alternative medicine. The Medical/Clinical Nutrition members translate nutrition knowledge from the bench to the bedside and the community. *The elected candidate serves a two-year term.*

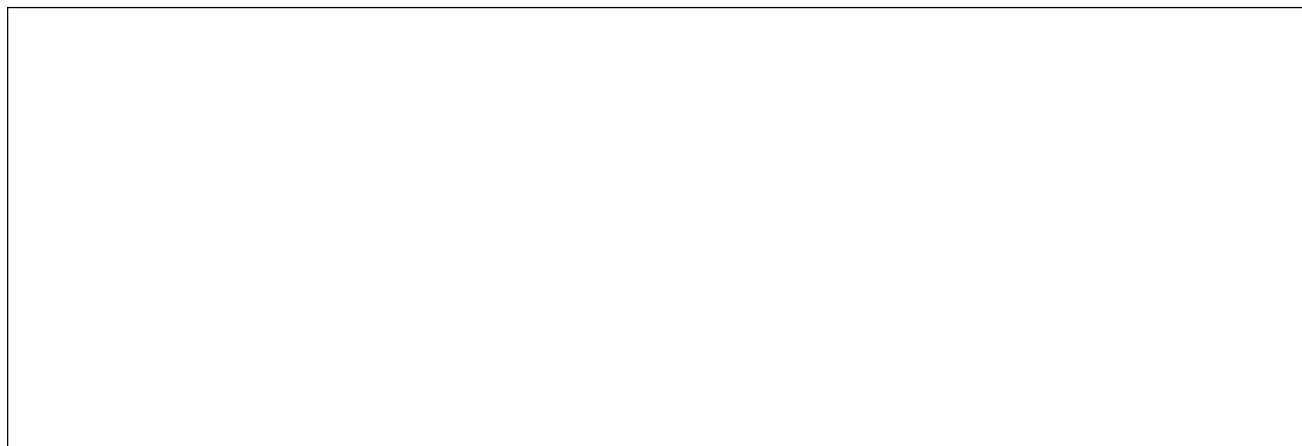
